Steve McHone and Chuck are working on getting prizes. Amanda will print the flyers for us and they will be added to our newsletter.
- 5. ACSC Summer Workshop Mary Gregory advised that the committees had been working very hard. Volunteers are still needed please contact a committee chairperson and offer your help. She also reminded us the even though we are members of the host club, we still have to pay the registration fee as everyone else

- does. As of meeting night, there are 403 people registered. La Quinta and Best Western still have a few rooms available. Rick Wolfe would like for volunteers to contact him regarding bringing food for the hospitality hours.
- 6. Luau Area Shag Club Party Brenda Smith reported that there was great response from the guests. Attendance was approximately 350 people. Brenda thanked everyone for his or her involvement and help and advised the door money paid for the allocation out of our treasury. A profit of \$1,200 was made for the night. The 50/50 winner, who was from the Steppin' Out Shag Club, took home \$320. The \$500 raffle was won by Tom Rich. Sheila Walker said they had about 40 of their students there and they really had a great time. Ronnie thanked everyone and said all the volunteers did a great job.
- 7. Christmas Party Brenda reminded everyone that it will be at the Moose Lodge on December 16th and it has been suggested having it catered. She is going to check into prices and report at a future meeting.
- 8. By Laws Sheila reminded everyone that there was a meeting scheduled on June 2nd to discuss and vote on changes, but only 17 members showed up. According to our current by-laws, this was not enough to take any votes. The meeting will be rescheduled. It was also noted that the telephone committee needs to call members ahead of the scheduled meeting date to remind them.

He advised they normally charge \$3500 for a Saturday booking, but would come down to \$2500. Ronnie opened the floor for discussion. Carol Pettigrew thought Coastline would be a better draw than the others even if it did cost us \$2,500 to book them. Chuck thought Rickey Godfrey would be a good draw. Peg Hansen thought Coastline would have come down more because of it being a charity event. Clint thought we should keep it in our community and book local bands, as did Evelyn who said we should consider Shaggie Maggie and Lia & The Wave combined. A new vote was taken and Coastline was the choice, even though it will cost \$2,500. Ronnie will call them.
