1. Ronnie opened the meeting at 8:09 p.m. and recognized new member, Jerry Dillard, from Hillsborough. Ronnie asked us to remember our sick or ailing members.
2. Secretary's report - there are currently 208 members. The minutes from the June meeting were printed in the July newsletter. There were no changes so the minutes will stand as printed.
3. Treasurer's report - Mary Gregory reported there is currently \$17,586.17 in the treasury. She explained income and expenses and passed out sheets for all members who were present.
4. By-Laws Meeting - After polling members present for convenient dates, Sheila Walker announced the by-laws meeting will be August 10th, a Thursday night, at the Ramada Inn at 7:00 p.m. She asked that members please take an interest in the governing of the club and attend this meeting.
5. Meals-On-Wheels - Ronnie announced that Al Fogleman has stepped aside as chairman of this event. Ronnie will set up a special meeting with officers and Anne Baker for initial discussion. He noted that the benefit has slipped some over the last few years and we need to bring the enthusiasm back into this event. He also said we would need all members to volunteer to help put on another successful benefit.
6. ACSC Summer Workshop - Mary thanked everyone who helped with all the work and said she was so proud of everyone who participated to put on this special event. Over 100 of our own members paid to attend. She heard so many compliments from guests, especially on how many of our members were working so hard to insure that our guests had such a fun weekend. There were 525 people registered. The financial figures were an income of \$36,488, expenses of \$24,437, leaving a profit of \$12,051. Rick Wolfe commented that none of this would have been a success if it had not been for Mary and her chair-people and 1-1/2 years of time-consuming work. Ronnie said he was so proud of the club and thanked those who worked so hard.
7. Membership Appreciation Pool Party - August 26th at the Ramada Inn. There will be a lot of surprises and loads of fun. There will be a DJ in Master's that night to keep the party going inside. There will be more info to come in the newsletter.

9. SOS Fun Monday - Joan Kimbro will be in charge of the booth again this year. Please contact her to volunteer some of your time to help. Ronnie asked for an allocation of \$1,000 for Fun Monday items for the booth and a vote passed. Some items from the summer workshop will also be given for booth sales.
10. Fun Monday Raffle Tickets - Mary has packets of 10 tickets for members to sell. If you sell 20 tickets, you will get a free ticket. We need to sell at least 100 for there to be no charge for our booth.


