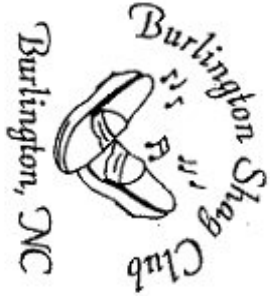

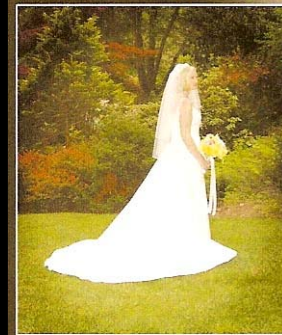

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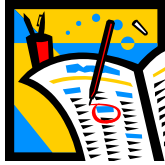

- The meeting was brought to order by Jim congratulating the club on the success of the Meals on Wheels event. - David Satterfield distributed and read the treasury report as of January 31st, 2007 – with an ending balance of \$11,672.70.
- Bylaws – Sheila announced the (hopefully) last meeting will be held by the Bylaws Review Committee on Thursday, March 8th at 7:00 PM at Ramada. Main topic that night will be whether the club will have a board or not. She encouraged all members to please attend.
- Shag Rag – Sheila Walker requested all members help solicit advertisers for our newsletter to help offset the printing, postage and other expenses of about \$2,100 annually. Mary Gregory will do a test newsletter via email to all those she has email addresses for in the next month or so to see what feedback is received. Please see Shelia for additional information on advertising in our

newsletter.

6. Winter Workshop – in Charleston this weekend – February 22nd-24th. Approximately 35 members from our shag club are planning on attending. BSC hospitality will be held from 4-6 PM on Saturday. Please come dressed in your flapper dresses and zoot suits.

7. DJ Throw down – March 1st – 3rd at North Myrtle Beach.

8. Eden's Mardi Gras Party will be held on March 10th – DJ is Roy “Shag Daddy” Childress.

9. Bowling Night – Mark your calendars for March 31st. BSC Bowling Night to be held at Country Club Lanes in Burlington. 3 games for \$10 for shag club members. 10. Cruise for 2008 – Pam McHone and Baxter Sellars distributed flyers concerning the cruise they are organizing. This flyer has been posted on the website. Anyone interested in going should have the first deposit of \$50 per person to Pam or Baxter by March 9th.

11. Entertainment – Stephanie West reported our area party (Luau) will be held the second weekend in June which will be the 9th. Motion was made and accepted for the shag club to commit \$1,500 to the party as was done in 2006. Moose Lodge was unanimously voted on as the location. DJ's were nominated and voted on and will be contacted in the near future to check their availability and interest. 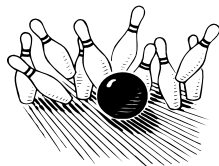
The only thing that I ask is that the items you submit would be typed verses hand written. I know at time this can not be helped, but it will make the development of the newsletter go a little quicker.
