There will be a Prostate Screening Fair held at the Alamance Cancer Center in September from 6:00-9:00 pm. I will have the date in the next issue. PSA blood test will be drawn as well local Urologist on hand for the rest of the exam. This fair is FREE. If you go to your physician for the same exam and lab work it would cost you approximately \$250.00 to \$300.00. The PSA test covers most of that charge due to most insurance not covering the cost of PSA tests and you pay out of pocket. When prostate cancer is left untreated, it goes directly to the bone and the outcome is very poor, recovery is impossible once it gets this far. Please guys, go have this done so we ladies have you around a long time to come. We need you in our lives as well as on the dance floor. Ladies do your part by encouraging all the guys to attend, it is just as important for them to have this exam as it is for you to have your mammograms and pap smears. If you need any further information, you may contact me at the Cancer Center at 586-3758 or 568-3906 which is Rita Agnew's number. Either of us can answer your questions concerning the tests provided or give you information you may need. As I said during the last business meeting, I see a lot of our members in the cancer center getting treatments and you know who you are, please help me to encourage the others to either come to this FREE screening or go to their physician and have this test done. It only takes a few minutes of your time and what is a few minutes when those few minutes can save your life??? I'll be waiting and I hope to hear from all you guys.
