



Tammy Allen has started chemo treatments and will continue them for 12 weeks. She will then start radiation treatments.


Sharon Russ had 4-way heart bypass surgery and is at home recuperating.

Marie Barber fell, sprained her ankle, and chipped a bone in her foot.


Charles Lindley's sister is very ill and in the hospital at Chapel Hill.
