




Float t-shirts will be given out this Friday night at Master's Lounge. Kim Hodge is in charge of giving them out, so please see her as soon as you get

Stephen stated that he has been in contact with several beach groups and have gotten some costs: Hip Pocket-\$2500.00, Holiday Band-\$3000.00, Jim Quick and Coastline-\$5000.00, Band of Oz-\$4000.00 and the Magnificents - \$2600.00. The floor was open to discuss other bands. Butch said that the Magnificents have told him that they are very eager to play for MOW. Stephen will pursue this further. He will keep checking with more bands also. MOW has already reserved Ramada Inn for next year.

ACSC Summer Workshop 2013: Joan mentioned that this is held in July each year. Brenda Smith asked if we wanted to pursue the bid for the 2013 summer workshop. The last time that we did this was in 2006. We missed the bid deadline for the 2011 workshop that was held in our zone. The next one in our zone is 2013. Evelyn Turner has agreed to chair this and prepare the presentation to be given to the ACSC at the summer workshop for 2011. Do we want to do this? It is a LOT of work, but the last time that we did this, we made \$22,000.00 which helped keep the coffers running for several years. Joan said that many of the other clubs are encouraging us to do this. There is great fellowship and opportunities to meet other clubs. Jackie Hallaman made a motion that we let ACSC know that we want to do this. Pam Hord seconded. Majority approved. Ronnie also suggested that we get information about availability and costs from Ramada Inn. Ronnie asked that this be tabled until we find this information out.

SOS 2012"Special" float: Ronnie stated that the ACSC has announced that the theme for the parade for Spring 2012 is "Year of the Book". This is in reference to a book being written, with Dr. Phil Sawyer's help, about the shag life, SOS and roots being released in 2012. The subtitle is "Bury My Heart at Ocean Drive". The ACSC has asked that Burlington Shag Club create a special float to honor this event and SOS. This float would be in addition to the club float that we already do. It is a great honor that they have asked us. They asked us to do this because of our history with the float themes and participation. We will have a year to do this and Mary Gregory and Brenda Smith have agreed to co-chair. When asked about the costs, Ronnie stated that SOS will be financing the float. Jackie Hallaman made a motion to do this. Gloria Thompson seconded. Ronnie Gregory made a motion for Brenda and Mary to co-chair the float build. Butch seconded. All approved.
