The balance was \$5226.03 and Joan has deposited \$5340.00 since this report was finalized on 6/12/11. Doug made a motion to accept the report as presented and Bill seconded. All approved.

Stephen Stearns has been in the hospital with blood clots in his leg. He went home but had to go back to the hospital 6/17/11 because he is still having problems. Fun Monday tickets: Edith has the Fun Monday tickets for the drawing on 9/19/11. Fun Monday: Mary announced that the booth rental is \$150.00 for the club, but if we sell 100 tickets, we get that money back. She also presented options for us to sell. We reviewed them and voted to sell the following: Backpacks with approved shagger design, foam visors in multiple colors with shaggers embroidered, lunch bags with shaggers (limiting to 15-20), t-shirts with dancers and shag printed below and tank-tops with the same shaggers emblem. She will set up a table at the August meeting for pre-sale to the club. Mary requested \$1500.00 to purchase these items and pay for designs. We should be able to recoup our expenses plus the same about or close for profit. Hugh made a motion that we allocate these funds as requested & Ronnie seconded. Majority approved. Mary stated that she will also have a sign up list in August for time to work the booth. **Hall of Fame:** Per Joan, Carol Pettigrew has agreed to chair this committee.

Nomination Committee for officers: Joan announced the Dianne and Lee Neese have agreed to chair this committee.

MOW: Stephen is still out, but the band has been booked and the contract signed for the event location, per Joan.

Eno Beach's Area Party: Joan stated that this took place on 5/21/11 and we had 37 BSC members attend. Mary won the best costume for the 50's.

ACSC Workshop: This is in Augusta, GA this year. Joan said that if you wanted to purchase your tickets, to do so before 6/20/11 as they are going up in price after that. There are also some rooms still available. We have been asked to host a hospitality room with the Coalition. This will cost us \$100.00. Doug made a motion to do this and Ronnie seconded. All approved.

Gold Tournament: A committee meeting will be scheduled soon.

We brought in \$7333.00, with \$4380.00 in expenses (this includes the payout for the sweepstakes and the 50/50), with an profit of \$2952.00. Eno Shag Club 20th Annual CSA Shag Contest: We have been asked to purchase an ad in their booklet. Full page \$100.00, ½ page \$75.00 and ¼ is \$50.00. Do we want to do this? Chip made a motion that we place a ½ page ad for \$75.00. Evelyn seconded and the majority approved.

Dancing with the Stars Contest: This contest will be held on 8/14/11 at TJ's in Raleigh. It will begin at 4:00 PM and food will be served.


