At the Willow Oak Beach Music Weekend Festival we have built a permanent stage for live bands and a wooden dance floor. Bring lawn chairs or a blanket and relax with friends in the open space of an outdoor amphitheater setting. The concert area is a well-groomed grass area with good visibility and is convenient to all the action. Various vendors will be on site to provide food and other items. You may bring a cooler with your favorite beverage, but absolutely no glass containers will be allowed. Coolers will be checked on entrance to grounds. Area shag clubs may have vendor booths set up or may want to have hospitality tents set up to have a gathering place or cookouts for their club members. Please contact us for vendor information. Spaces for party tents are available around perimeter of seating area by reservation. No tents, umbrellas, or other items that would obstruct the view of others will be permitted inside the concert area.

For those who prefer to stay overnight at the park, we have about 100 electric hook-up sites and plenty of RV/camping non-electric sites available. There is a two day minimum to reserve an electric site. If camping is not your thing---not to worry--hotels are available in Roxboro only 10 minutes away. We will have a shuttle bus running to and from area hotels so you don't need to worry about driving. If you choose to drive, parking is free when you park in the one-day lot, but if you want to park in the camping area, and are not camping, there is a \$5.00 per day parking fee. Whether you come for the entire weekend, or one day, or just for an evening out, we will try our best to make it an enjoyable experience that you look forward to every year.
