At the March 15 Business Meeting, checks will be presented to Hospice and MOW representatives. Also, Kim mentioned BSC has booked the 40 West Convention Center for our 2020 Valentine Dinner/Dance. The SOS Parade will soon be here and you can show your support of our Burlington Shag Club by proudly wearing your Parade Day T-shirts during the parade and at the parade party. You




